Instructions for the correct use and maintenance of MePas (metal panels)

Please use the following precautions:

Transport, storage, handling

- Do not accept the product if the package has been damaged
- Do not crush, bend or stack weights on the product even if it is still packed
- Although MePas are adequately packed they may be damaged by incorrect handling.

To unpack cylinders

- Set up a sufficiently large table top
- Open the cylinder in two people
- Pull out the roll from the tube without bending the edges
- Remove carefully the adhesive paper tape or the plastic wrap. **Be careful: rolled panels work as a spring!**
- Slowly unroll until the complete distension of panels.

When handling the panels

- Use gloves to avoid stains on the steel surface
- Panels must be always handled by two persons, held by the ends
- Do not bend or excessively curve the panels
- While handling curvatures must be gentle avoiding irreversible bending and damage.

Maintenance

MePas are usually made of stainless steel, an oxidation resistant material. Anyway, to preserve its shine, you should:

- Use gloves when fixing the panels
- Immediately remove any fingerprints or grease stains with soap and water or alcohol
- Do not clean with acidic products such as bleach or hydrochloric acid
- If necessary, use specific stainless steel cleaning products following the manufacturer's instructions
- Do not expose the panels to outdoor saline environments unless they are made of a special stainless steel or titanium.

Safety

MePas are thin metal panels (0,3 - 0,5 mm) with etched designs and may cause cuts or pricks if incorrectly used. The following precautions should be always used:

- MePas must be safely fixed to ceilings or walls
- If exposed to air currents MePas must be fixed to avoid them swaying or knocking into objects or people
- MePas should not be installed in environments with unsupervised children
- MePas are electricity conductors and must not be in contact with electrical cables or high voltage equipment.
